Dump Cake Recipe

2 (15 oz) cans fruit

1 box cake mix

1 stick margarine or butter

Drain fruit and save the juice. Dump fruit in greased pan (13 \times 9). Spread evenly. Dump cake mix on fruit and spread evenly. Cut stick of margarine/butter and lay evenly on top of cake mix. Drizzle fruit juice on top. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 – 45 minutes or until golden brown.
