Trouble Shooting Your Air Conditioner

If you want your AC unit to have a long and productive life, have an AC specialist do preventive maintenance at least yearly.

But there are also steps the homeowner can take to trouble shoot issues.

- * Air filters- During high usage times, change the filter monthly.
- * Thermostat- Make sure the setting is on cool and the temp of your choice. Thermostats may be hard wired or battery operated. If there is no display, change the battery to return this function.
- * If the unit is not running, check the overflow condensation drain. This drain needs to be clear and draining for the unit to work. By instilling vinegar or Clorox down the drain frequently, the drain will remain clear.
- * If the fan unit is not running, check the breakers.
- * If there is ice on the lines, shut the outside unit off for a few hours to allow the ice to melt. Then turn it back on. There are many competent AC companies and repairmen in Cocoa Beach. If none of the trouble shooting methods work, contact a company for a service call.
