Harbor Isles Phase 1 Condominium Association New Leasing Rule

Adopted by the Board of Directors on May 26, 2015 New Addition to Rule is **bold** type and <u>underlined</u>.

Leasing — Units may not be leased by a unit owner within the first twelve (12) months of ownership. When a unit is leased, the lease agreement must include the unit's assigned garage. No unit may be leased to a business or corporation. Units may be leased to individuals or a single family but not to multiple families. The minimum lease is three (3) months and no more than two (2) leases are allowed per year. Whoever is named on the lease must be in residence during the period of the lease. Units may not be split in duration, time-shared or sublet at any time during the lease. Lease approval must be requested in advance by submitting a completed Tenant Application Form accompanied by a non-refundable Application Fee of \$50.00 to the condominium Board of Administration. A copy of the Tenant-Lease Agreement must also accompany the Tenant Application Form. Leases must incorporate the condo documents by reference and the unit owner must inform the tenant of condominium rules.
